## Successes obtained direct from the School during 1940-41

(in spite of Evacuation Difficulties).

**Loss of Numbers.**—In October, 1940, the number in the School was slightly under normal ... .. 680  
In spite of constant raids this number was maintained, and in March 1941, was ... .. 640  
After the Blitz in the Easter vacation, only 50 boys appeared on May 1st (the new term).  
By Evacuation date, May 14th, this number had increased to 433  
380 boys travelled to Penzance; 53 remained in Devonport.

**Interference.**—The Evacuation covered the first days of the Summer Term (the Examination Term).  
The final settlement into School hostels covered three months (the Summer Term).
