In order that the Boys shall not be denied the honour of presentation owing to leaving before Speech Day it has been decided that the School Office holders should be presented during their term of office.

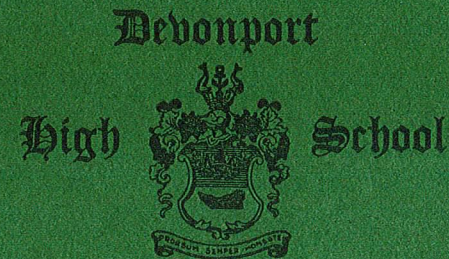
